Choosing the electric vehicle that is right for you with ChooseEV

Are you ready to dive into the world of electric vehicles but are a little nervous about the overall commitment costs? Harrison REMC is here to help.

All-electric vehicles run solely on an electric motor and battery power. They burn no gasoline or diesel fuel, so they have no exhaust emissions. Since battery technology is rapidly advancing, the costs associated with electric vehicles are declining and their range between charges is increasing.

Plug-in hybrids pair an electric motor and battery with an internal combustion engine. Plug-in hybrids drive solely on electricity until the battery is mostly empty. Then the engine turns on, and the car drives like a conventional hybrid.

Making the leap a little easier

As part of Cooperative Charge, Harrison REMC is offering Enel X JuiceBox Level 2 chargers, at no cost, for home installation while supplies last. These high-tech chargers offer memberconsumers

the ability to charge an all-electric vehicle, on their schedule, while at home. In order to participate in this program, a member must have recently purchased an all-electric vehicle and have a WiFi connection at their home. Plug-in hybrids are not qualified for participation in this program.

JuiceBox charger requirements

The chargers provided by Harrison REMC are Enel X JuiceBox Level 2 chargers. These chargers can be mounted to a wall and only require a



standard dryer NEMA14-50 outlet plug (50A circuit). Chargers may be placed inside or outside and have a three-year warranty. Plus, there is an app available for download to help users with

charging information like state of charge, set-up reminders for charging, charging scheduls, etc. The chargers are also Alexa or Google Home compatible.

While your co-op will provide the limited number of chargers free of cost, members are responsible for fees associated with charger installation and maintenance.

In order to participate in Cooperative Charge, a member must have WiFi and be able to connect the JuiceBox charger to WiFi within 45 days of receipt. The member must also provide proof of an all-electric vehicle purchase. With the WiFi uplink, the co-op will have access to the information on the Enel X system. This information will be gathered for the sole purpose of researching charging patterns, charging station capabilities and other related charging information.
