



About the Program

Your electric cooperative is offering a 2023 residential rebate for qualifying equipment (heat pump water heaters, geothermal heat pumps and air source, ductless mini-split or dual fuel heat pumps). To qualify, you must occupy the home where the equipment is installed year-round (12 months) and the unit must heat and cool the whole home, unless otherwise stated.

Please provide the following documents to your electric cooperative to apply for possible rebates*:

- AHRI (Air-conditioning, Heating and Refrigeration Institute) certificate for validation of all SEER ratings.
 (This can be obtained from the installing heating and cooling contractor.)
- 2023 Residential Rebate Application
- Proof of purchase (invoice or receipt)

MINIMUM EFFICIENCY REQUIREMENTS

Stick-built or modular housing SEER \geq 16, EER \geq 10

Mobile/Manufactured Housing ⁽¹⁾ SEER ≥ 14, EER ≥ 10 AIR SOURCE (ASHP) (2) (replacing gas, existing A/C or heat pump or new construction installation)

Dual/Variable/Multi-Speed Compressor ONLY (3)

Additional incentive if installed with gas/propane backup (dual-fuel)

The following DO NOT qualify for 100% electric resistance replacement:

HEAT PUMP (replacing 100% electric resistant heat) (must be replacing primary heat source for entire home)

Single-Speed Compressor (mobile/manufactured only) \$750

Dual/Variable/Multi-Speed Compressor

\$1,450

Heat pump with electric resistance, space heaters, gas furnace, wood stove, wood pellet stove, A/C, back-up heat, generators.

Mobile/manufactured homes are defined as factory assembled, transportable, designed for transportation on own chassis, can be placed on temporary or permanent foundation and intended for year-round occupancy.

- Units that do not qualify include: window air conditioners and "thru-the wall" heat pumps (hotel-type machines).
- ⁽³⁾ Single-speed compressors for mobile/manufactured homes only qualify.

Modular homes must be residential single-family homes.

TO QUALIFY:

- HVAC unit must be located in a home served by Harrison REMC.
- Unit must be 3 or more years old and not have an existing preventative maintenance contract or agreement.
- The tuneup must be performed by a licensed HVAC contractor with itemized receipt.
- Submission for rebates must be within 90 days of tuneup service in the same calendar year.
- One rebate per member account per calendar year.
- Approved rebates will be returned to the customer in the form of a bill credit.
- Rebate participation is subject to funding availability. First-come, first-served applications until funding is exhausted.

Terms and Conditions

The following terms and conditions apply to all residential rebate programs. For specific program requirements, please read the rules and requirements within each application.

Eligibility Requirements

- Must be a current Harrison REMC residential consumermember.
- Equipment installations or upgrades must be in a home served by Harrison REMC.
- Applicant must occupy the home where the equipment is installed year-round (12 months).
- Program eligibility includes prior participation in rebate programs, with incentive and measure caps specific for each program. Applications in excess of program caps will not be processed.

HVAC Rebate Program Requirements

- The HVAC rebate is designed for installation or upgrades of water heaters, geothermal heat pumps and air source, ductless mini-split, or dual fuel heat pumps.
- 6. Rebates for HVAC equipment are for whole-home installations only unless otherwise stated.
- All homeowners must provide AHRI (Air-conditioning, Heating and Refrigeration Institute) validation for all SEER and EER ratings. This information is obtained from the installing heating and cooling contractor. This certificate must be submitted with the application.
- Submission for HVAC rebate must include application, AHRI Certificate and itemized receipt or invoice.
 Applicant understands no rebate will be given if applicant and/or applicant's contractor fails to provide required documentation.
- No rebate will be awarded based on HVAC dealer bid specifications, promotional materials of dealer, manufacturer or any source, other than AHRI Certificate.
- Prior approval is required for electric resistance incentives.
- Limit of two rebates per household. Rebates are not available for replacement of previously rebated equipment during its deemed useful life as determined by Hoosier Energy.

Program Parameters

- All rebated equipment must be new. Used or rebuilt equipment is not eligible for an incentive.
- 13. Rebated equipment must meet all requirements from the manufacturer's warranty.
- 14. Rebated equipment must meet the technical specifications listed in the application form.
- 15. Applicant agrees to purchase power from Harrison REMC for a period not less than the deemed measured useful life of rebated equipment. Should the applicant receive power from any source other than Harrison REMC, including generation owned by the customer before the end of the equipment's deemed useful life,

- the applicant agrees to refund the full amount of the rebate to Harrison REMC.
- Hoosier Energy maintains full discretion over the rebate and reserves the right to modify the program at any time

Application Procedures and Deadlines

- Applications are processed on a first-come, first-served basis while funds are available.
- 18. Submission for rebates must be within 90 days of installation in the same calendar year.
- Applications become the property of Harrison REMC and will not be returned. Please keep a copy for your records.

Right to Confirm Installation

- 20. Pre-install inspection: Harrison REMC reserves the right to inspect the program participant's premises to verify that equipment meeting program qualifications exists prior to providing an incentive. The program participant agrees to provide reasonable access to the premises for such purposes.
- 21. Post-install inspection: Harrison REMC reserves the right to inspect the program participant's premises to verify that equipment matching the information provided on the program application has been placed in service at that location. The program participant agrees to provide reasonable access to the premises for such purposes.
- Post-inspection: The program participant will have 30 days from the request date to submit any additional information requested by Harrison REMC. Failure to submit requested information may result in application rejection.
- 23. If any requested inspection finds the program participant or the program participant's contractor did not comply with program rules and standards, any incentive received must be returned to Harrison REMC within 60 days of notice of such inspection.
- 24. Harrison REMC reserves the right to conduct an additional post-install inspection for program portfolio evaluation, measurement and verification (EM&V) purposes. Incentives received will not be affected by the results of this inspection.

Incentive Payments

- 25. Harrison REMC reserves the right to approve, deny or select appropriate incentive.
- The incentive payment cannot exceed 75% of the total equipment cost. Installation, taxes and fees cannot be included in the equipment cost.
- 27. Rebates may take up to six weeks from receipt of the

- application by Harrison REMC to process.
- Approved rebates will be returned to the applicant in the form of a bill credit on the member's electric account.
- Application approval is not a guarantee of incentive payment.
- Harrison REMC reserves the right to withhold payment for products that do not meet the program requirements as determined within its sole discretion.
- 31. Harrison REMC is not liable for incentives promised to members as a result of a contractor misrepresenting or not verifying the rules of the program. Only Harrison REMC has the right to approve an application and the incentives.
- Incentives are paid as a one-time, one-program offer and cannot be combined with incentive payments, rebates, or discount programs from other utility providers.
